The Four Way Test

- The 24 words of the Four Way Test is the genetic code of Rotary....
- It was written by Herbert J. Taylor in 1932 and it the ethical yardstick for every Rotarian.
- 3. Before implementing the 4 way test, Taylor consulted with a Roman Catholic, a Christian Scientist, and Orthodox Jews and a Presbyterian to make sure nothing was in conflicted with their religious or, moral beliefs.
- 4. Taylor believed that God has a plan for all of us.
- Taylor view Rotary as a maker of friendships, a builder of men and communities and a creator of goodwill and friendship between the peoples of the world.
- 6. Taylor was called to Washington to serve as one of the nation's "dollar a year" men. This was a group of Business Executives who worked for the government to help drive the economy.
- 7. Newsweek during this period saluted Rotary for having "broken through the barriers of race, religion and language as government and church have seldom been able to do"
